

No Ladder Wreath Hanging

Supplies Needed: (No outside ladder required!)

Wreaths – 1 per window
Ribbons – 1 per wreath
Tiny Eye Hooks – 1 per wreath
Key Rings – 1 per wreath

Fishing Line
Scissors
Label maker or
Masking tape & Sharpie Marker

2 Needle-nose pliers
1 Drill
1 Tiny Drill Bit



2. Stretch open your Eye Hook enough to allow Key Ring to fit through opening

1. Size your drill bit to your Eye Hook



4. Screw Eye Hook into pre-drilled hole.

3. Measure to center – same spot on each window frame.

Secure Drill Bit in power drill & make a hole the depth of your Eye Hook threads.



5. Tie Fishing Line on Wreath & on Key Ring. Ensure uniform Length among all wreaths, based on actual Eye-Hook location. Label Ring according to window, as hook location may vary slightly.



6. Stretch Fishing line to ensure you can Hook Key Ring onto Eye Hook. Attach the ribbon, centered.



7. Pull down top window. Hook Key Ring onto Eye Hook. Hang Wreath Outside window. Fishing line goes between window and frame.



8. Complete!

At the End of the Season:

Leave up the Eye-Hooks for next year! Unhook Key Rings.

Remove Ribbons & store separately. Wrap Fishing Line around it's wreath, with label sticking out. Store stacked in a box/ bag in the order you put them up/ take them down. Enjoy!
